WFMP Referral Corner

Recently you may have seen a news report about some Referrals being lost in the ConnectCare system. ConnectCare is the Electronic Medical Record that is used by Alberta Health Services in Hospitals and other AHS locations. Doctors' offices and many other Health care providers do not use ConnectCare. If you were seen by a Doctor in a Hospital, perhaps in the Emergency Department or you were an Inpatient, your referral may have been submitted through ConnectCare. If your referral is one of the affected ones, you will receive a letter from AHS explaining what happened and the next steps to take.

If you have any questions or concerns about any referral, please reach out to the Referral Department at WFMP and we will find the answers for you. Our job here at WFMP is to make sure that your referral is sent to the correct Specialist in a way in which they can receive it and we follow-up with every referral to make sure it was received by the specialist.
